THIS BUILDING WILL BE FUMIGATED WITH LETHAL GASES ON THE DATE(S) INDICATED ABOVE. ALL PERSONS AND ANIMALS MUST VACATE THE PREMISES ON OR BEFORE ARRIVAL OF THE FUMIGATION CREW.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES CAN ANYONE ENTER THE BUILDING UNTIL THE FUMIGATION COMPANY'S NOTICE IS POSTED GIVING THE TIME AND DATE FOR SAFE RE-ENTRY.

"State law requires that you be given the following information: CAUTION-PESTICIDES ARE TOXIC CHEMICALS. Structural pest control companies are registered and regulated by the Structural Pest Control Board, and apply pesticides which are registered and approved for use by the California Department of Pesticide Regulation and the United States Environmental Protection Agency. Registration is granted when the State finds that based on existing scientific evidence there are no appreciable risks if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by the benefits. The degree of risk depends upon the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized."

If within 24 hours you experience symptoms of dizziness, headache, nausea, reduced awareness, slowed movement, garbled speech or difficulty in breathing, leave the structure immediately and seek medical attention by contacting your physician or Poison Control Center (telephone number) and notify your pest control company. The warning agent, chloropicrin, can cause symptoms of tearing, respiratory distress and vomiting. Entry into the space during fumigation can be fatal.

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TERMS, CONDITIONS AND LIABILITIES

1. Fumigation crews perform several jobs in various locations daily. Therefore, any time call provided is an estimate. We do not wish to inconvenience you by having you wait for our arrival on the fumigation date. Therefore, it is recommended that you make key arrangements with your termite inspector in advance and leave with the assurance that your building will be properly fumigated and safe for re-entry upon your return. These keys must provide access to ALL parts of the building to be fumigated including garages and rooms that area normally locked. Any vehicles that must be left in the structure under fumigation must have the windows down and the trunk open.

WE MUST HAVE A COMPLETE SET OF KEYS TO THE PROPERTY

2. Electricity must be available at the property to perform the fumigation. Power is necessary for circulation fans, as well as for electronic monitoring devices to verify fumigant dosages and to clear the property for re-entry upon completion.
3. Be advised, in the event of inclement weather, the job may have to be postponed to a later date. We request an emergency phone number on the front of this form so that you may be reached.
4. The occupant is responsible for exterior preparation, removal and/or bagging of all ingestible items, and removal of all people, pets and plant life prior to the fumigation crew's scheduled arrival. We reserve the right to cancel and/or reschedule the fumigation if these preparations are not performed.
5. Occupants are responsible for bagging and removing all ingestible items not factory sealed in glass or metal containers. This includes items in the refrigerator and freezer, medicines, spices, and opened liquor bottles. Only special NYLOFUME bags may be used for this process. See the attached instruction sheet for specific details. Improperly bagged or unbagged ingestibles will be bagged by the fumigation crew at a minimal charge of at least \$20.00 per bag. Note: Vikane is not registered for fumigation of prepared foodstuff. Therefore, food must be removed or bagged as a requirement rather than out of fear of contamination.
6. Do you as owner, occupant, contractor or realtor have any knowledge of any apparatus or equipment located on the ground, underground or overhead which might allow the fumigant to travel from the building(s) being fumigated to any adjacent occupied structure? These means of connections may include, but not be limited to, underground electrical conduit, underground plumbing lines which are not sealed with water, overhead conduits which are connecting one building to another and connecting central vacuum systems. If two or more buildings are connected by any of these means and it is not possible to contain the fumigant in the desired structure, it will be necessary to vacate the non-fumigated structure. All preparations and instructions such as food removal or bagging and all other instructions must be followed as well. Under no circumstances will the adjacent connected non-fumigated building be allowed to remain occupied.

8. Regardless if access to adjacent properties is required or not, notify all neighbors with cats of your scheduled fumigation and request they keep their animals away from your property during this process. Close any access to sub-areas on your building well in advance of the fumigation date to prevent cats from entering.
9. Due to the nature of the fumigation process, there are certain potential property damages and/or necessary alterations that are inherent to the job. Though it is always our intent to make a conscientious effort to minimize this situation, neither company nor our licensed fumigators will assume any liability for such damages as listed below or those similar in scope.
- a. The roof covering and area below must be walked upon and damages may occur. This includes consequential damage that may arise later, damage to attached butters, wiring, patio and awning covers, cover heating panels and utmost care will be utilized, we can assume no liability for such damages.
- b. The perimeter area and landscaping around the building must be walked upon and tarpaulins must be weighted down in place against the base of the building. Plants in close proximity to the building could be subjected to trample damage or damage from the fumigant itself. In some circumstances, plants may have to be covered and will die. During preparations, occupants are responsible for detaching any climbing plants, fences, trellises and vines from the building. However, if forgotten or missed, these items may be damaged when removed by our fumigation crews. **We can assume no liability for such damages.**
- c. We do not provide on-site security during the fumigation. As such our insurance does not cover, and we will not be responsible for, any loss or damage due to vandalism, theft, or other acts of third parties. For general information, it is possible that normally inaccessible screened windows (i.e. 2nd floor windows) on barred windows may be left open and unlocked to allow proper ventilation of your property.
- d. The fumigation process requires the use of masking tape and spray adhesive. When applied to stucco and painted surfaces. Where the surface is old, oxidized or the paint has been improperly applied, peeling and chipping will occur. Residue from the adhesive may result in discoloration on painted or stucco walls. This is an inherent process and we assume no responsibility for such damages.
- e. During the tenting process, antennas and/or satellite dishes may be covered, moved or taken down. Normally, we request that these items are removed prior to fumigation. However, if left in place, we are not liable for any damages that occur, or more. Likely, any adjustments that must be made to the antenna or satellite dish to improve reception.
- f. Old gas or water pipes may be damaged during the fumigation process. Faulty gas mains or those with earthquake valves installed may not reset properly. Old or faulty furnaces and water heaters may not relight properly. We assume no liability for damages to these items and recommend owners coordinate any necessary repairs with the Gas Company and/or plumber.
- g. Due to the fragile nature in which mobile homes are constructed, some damage may occur to carports, roof nails, roofs, or siding. Although utmost care will be taken, we can assume no liability for such damage.
- h. All exterior door (including water heater cabinets) must be lockable. If no hasp or other interior/exterior-locking device exists, state law requires nailing these doors shut. If no other adequate locking means is provided, and the fumigation licensee is required to nail a door shut, we assume no liability for resulting damages to include those to the door and doorjamb.
- i. Out licensed fumigators are responsible for verifying that occupants performed their interior preparations as directed and in a manner consistent with the fumigant product label. However, missed food or interior plants that were not removed remain the prime responsibility of the occupant. We can assume no liability for those items missed by the occupant and subsequently damaged or rendered useless as a result of the fumigation process.
